WHEREAS, a petition for organization was presented to the Board of Lincoln County Commissioners pursuant to W.S. 18-12-101 et seq. and an election was held on the question of formation of the Broken Wheel Ranch Improvement and Service District and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 22-29-114 (e) the judges of that election have certified the returns of the election to us, the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the judges have certified to us that the votes cast at the election held on January 17, 2017 on the question of organization of the Broken Wheel Ranch Improvement and Service District were as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Broken Wheel Ranch Improvement and Service District is hereby declared organized and shall be

known with the Corporate name of the Broken Wheel Ranch Improvement and Service District as set forth in the petition and shall be a governmental subdivision of the State of Wyoming and the named individuals are hereby designated as the first board of directors under the applicable laws of the State of Wyoming.
